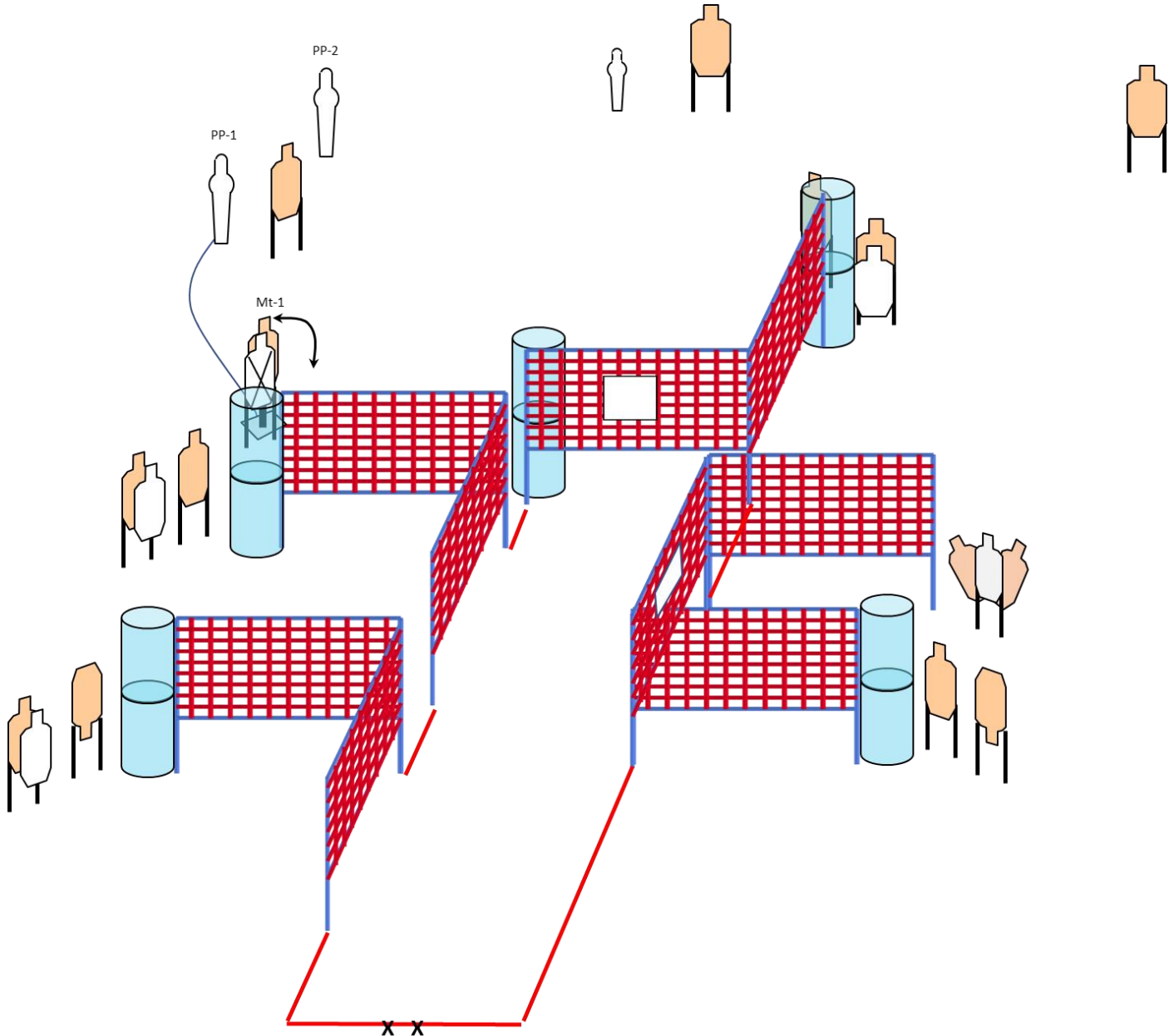

1

START POSITION: Facing downrange with heels on marks and wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun - is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2. - PCC – is loaded with stock touching belt and muzzle pointed downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. PP-1 activates MT-1. MT-1 remains visible when at rest. All walls extend to ground and upwards to infinity.

SCORING: Comstock, 31 rounds, 155 points
TARGETS: 14 Metric, 2 PP, 1 MP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD Steel = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
RULES: USPSA current edition

START POSITION: Facing downrange with hands relaxed at sides and toes touching marks. Firearm is unloaded and placed on center of table with muzzle pointed downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At start signal, retrieve and load firearm and then engage all targets from within the shooting area. All ammo must come from the belt. All walls extend to the ground and upwards to infinity.

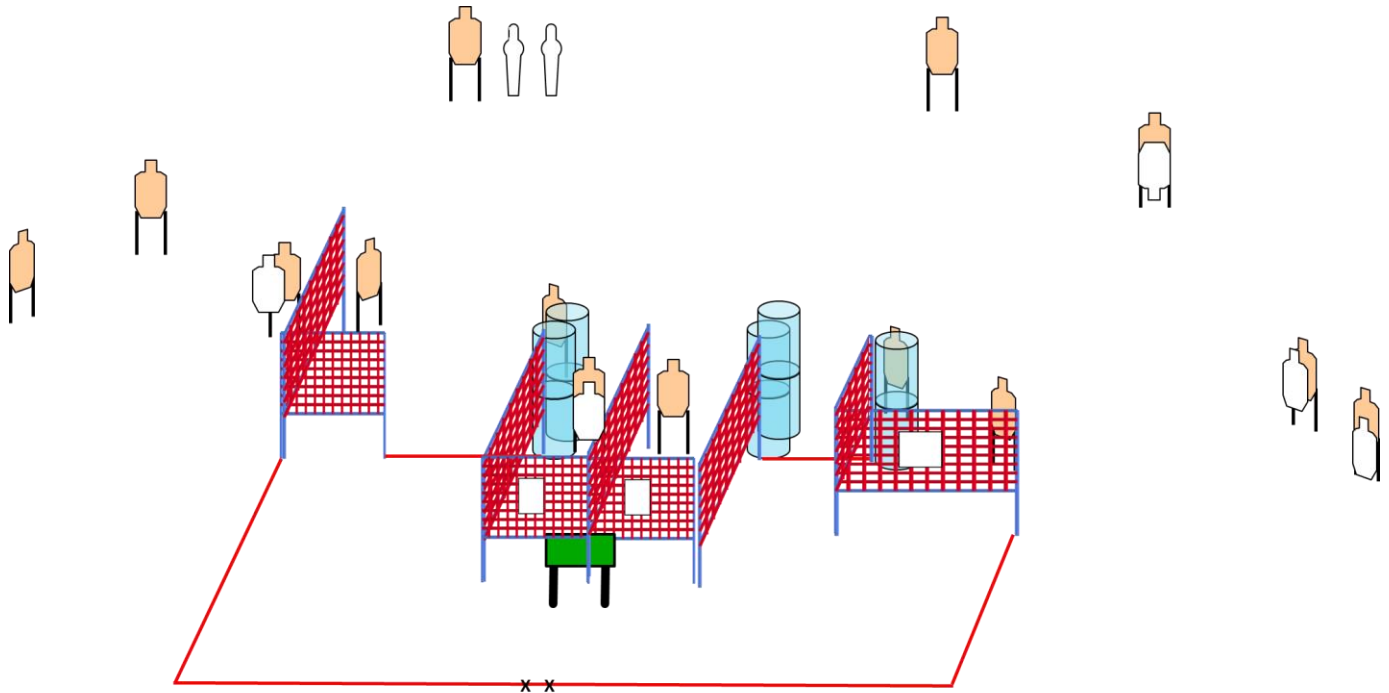
SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points

TARGETS: 14 Metric, 2 PP

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD Steel = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

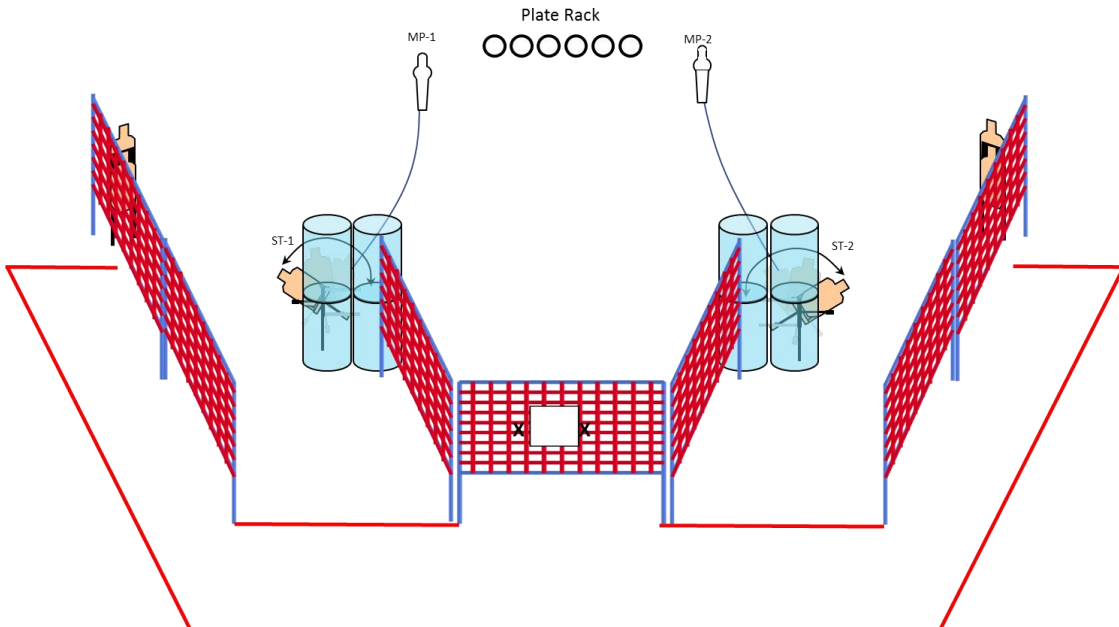
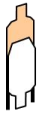

START POSITION: Facing downrange with hands on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2. PCC – Facing downrange with PCC loaded, Stock is touching belt and muzzle is pointed downrange touching either mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. MP-1 activates ST-1. MP-2 activates ST-2. ST-1 and ST-2 do not remain visible when at rest. All walls extend to ground and upwards to infinity. Shooter must remain in the shooting area (DQ for intentionally leaving shooting – safety/trip hazard).

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 12 Metric, 2 MP, 6 Steel
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
RULES: USPSA current edition

START POSITION: Facing downrange with hands relaxed at sides. Handgun is unloaded and holstered. PCC – PCC is unloaded with stock touching belt and muzzle pointed down range.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At start signal, load firearm and then engage all targets from within the shooting box with one shot each. Then perform a mandatory reload and then re-engage each target with one shot each from within the shooting area. All ammo must come from the belt.

SCORING: Virginia, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

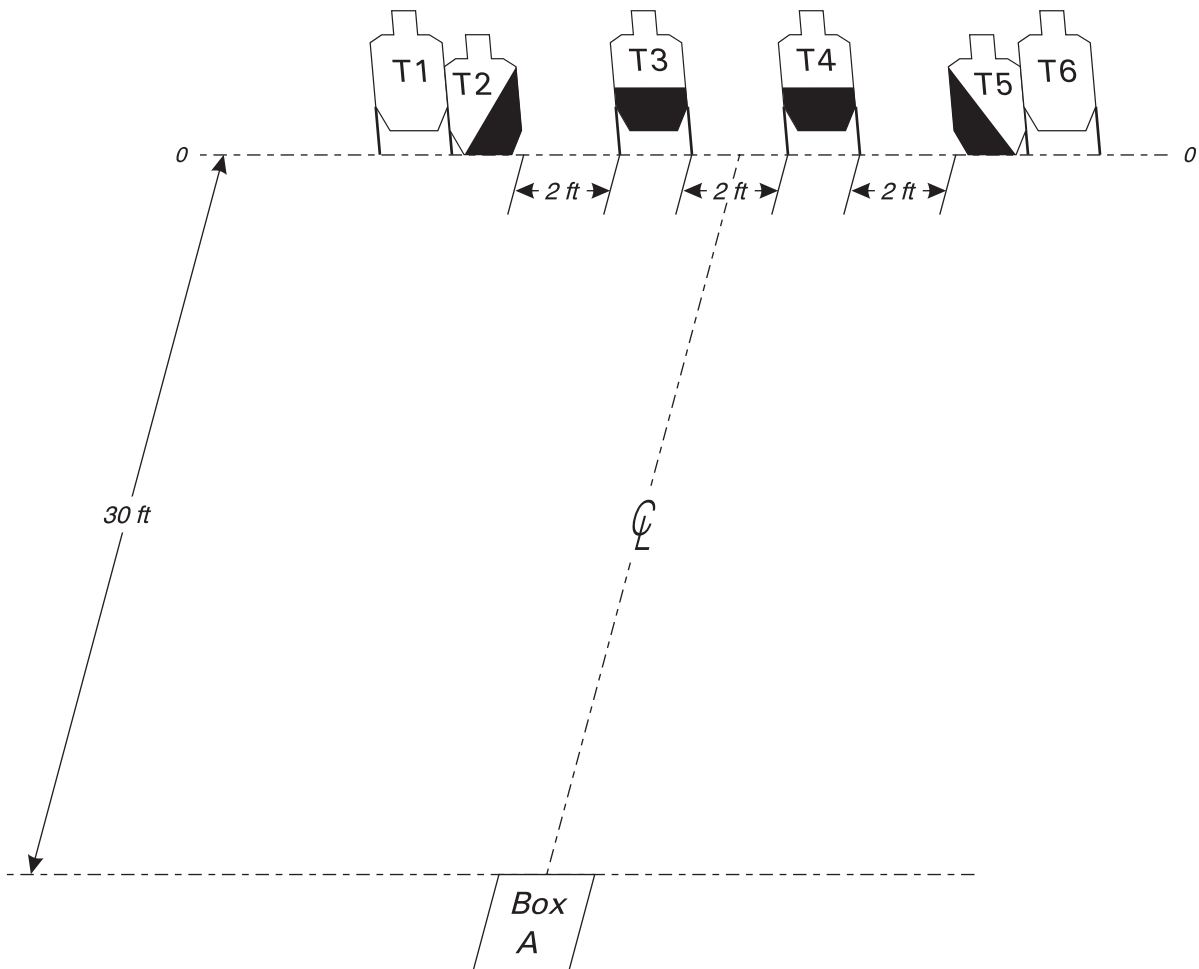
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn, then draw and from Box A engage T1-T6 with only one round per target, then make a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T6 with only one round per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 6 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Handgun Competition Rules
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set T1, T3, T4, and T6 to 5 feet high at shoulders. T2 and T5 are set so top of upper A zones are parallel with top of shoulder on adjacent target. Outer non-scoring edges of T1-T2 and T5-T6



butt together. Other targets are spaced two feet apart edge to edge. Shooting box is 3 feet by 3 feet. Hard cover on T3 & T4 is to bottom perforation of lower A zone. Hard cover on T2 & T5 is as shown.

START POSITION: Facing downrange with toes on marks. Firearm is unloaded and placed on one of the barrels in the shooting area with the muzzle pointed downrange. All ammo for the stage is placed on the barrels in the shooting area at the start of the stage.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At start signal, retrieve firearm and load, then engage all targets from within the shooting area. All walls extend to ground and upwards to infinity.

SCORING: Comstock, 27 rounds, 135 points
TARGETS: 10 Metric, 2 MP, 5 Steel
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD Steel = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
RULES: USPSA current edition
